The Summit at Park Hills Opens Samara Memory Care

FAIRBORN, Ohio – The Summit at Park Hills assisted living center is celebrating the grand opening of 24 units specializing in care for senior adults with Alzheimer’s, dementia and memory loss. Earlier this fall, staff began moving residents into the \$3.5 million addition.

The memory care facility, named Samara Memory Care, provides a high staff to resident ratio, which allows for a very individualized approach that focuses on the resident’s abilities. Staff members help each resident achieve daily successes based on his/her abilities.

For example, a resident may love to bake but be unable to follow a recipe because of memory loss. Staff members coach the resident through the steps of baking cookies, focusing on tasks the resident can still accomplish.

As a result of the expansion, the facility is employing an additional 12 full-time individuals, including professional nurses, therapists and direct care staff.

“Samara provides a very different alternative for family members searching for a home for those suffering from memory loss,” said Todd Spittal, co-owner and president of Provision Living, which is the operator for The Summit at Park Hills. “We’re
